EXECUTIVE BOARD MINUTES

-Recruiting statement:

The ICSGA does not allow the recruiting of student for the sole purpose of athletic participation.

-Talked about the issue of AAU and select teams. Concluded that all contact with your own teams was permitted through the end of the school year. The logic behind this is that, many schools already do this through their PE courses.

-Beginning June 1st through July 31st a coach may hold or participate in two summer camps per sport. No volleyball or football camps that last week of July. This would be a "dead period" for these two sports.

-Any coach on your staff may get together with up to two players who will be on the next seasons roster, for the purpose of skill development. This does not include conditioning programs.

-If a head coach or a staff coach coach any Select or AAU type teams the proceeding rule applies. (Only 2 roster players from the up coming season may participate on that team. Any discrepancy needs to be self reported and administration needs to be involved.
